## **ARMED ROBBERY**

LINCOLN, CA, June 24, 2009 – At approximately 12:45 p.m. Lincoln Police Officers responded to the Twelve Bridges Pharmacy located at 835 Twelve Bridges Drive, Lincoln, for an armed robbery that had just occurred. The suspect walked into the pharmacy, displayed a semi-automatic handgun, and demanded narcotics. The suspect left the pharmacy with an undisclosed amount of narcotics. The suspect is described as a white male adult, 20 to 25 years old, 5'-10" and 150 pounds with an acne scarred face. The suspect was wearing a black shirt, black pants, a tan fishing hat and aviator glasses. No one was injured during the robbery.

The suspect was seen running behind the business and getting into a late model white Toyota pick-up truck, where a second suspect was waiting. The vehicle was last seen traveling northbound on Highway 65 from Twelve Bridges Drive at a high rate of speed. The robbery is currently under investigation by Lincoln Police detectives.
