LINCOLN, CA, July 10, 2007– At approximately 7:50 p.m. on July 9th, the Lincoln Police Department received a call of an armed robbery at the Starbucks Coffee House located at 445 South Highway 65.

The female victim called police to report she and a friend were robbed of their purses by two male subjects armed with a knife. The suspects then fled northbound on G Street in a gold sedan. A Lincoln Police Officer saw a vehicle matching the description pulling into the Circle K parking lot at 7th and G Streets. A high risk enforcement stop on the vehicle was conducted and the subjects were detained.

Upon a search of the vehicle, the victims' stolen properties, along with a knife, were recovered. All five juveniles were arrested and transported to Placer Juvenile Hall. Upon a further search of the vehicle, several items of stolen property from crimes outside the city were located and additional charges added. The Lincoln Police Department is continuing its investigation into this case.
