LINCOLN, CA, October 12, 2009 -- At approximately 9:10 a.m. on October 11th, Lincoln Police officers were dispatched to the 100 block of East 5th Street regarding the kidnapping of three teenagers (13 to 15 years old) which had just occurred. Upon arrival, officers learned that three adult male suspects entered the residence and kidnapped three juveniles by force.

The suspects forced the juveniles into two separate vehicles and left. While officers were taking the report on East 5th Street, they received a call of a verbal disturbance involving two SUV's (blue Ford Expedition and a tan GMC Suburban) in the 400 block of Phoenix Circle. One of the kidnap victims was seen inside one of the vehicles.

Lincoln police officers responded to Phoenix Circle and saw both SUV's leaving the area and followed them. Police officers stopped the Ford Expedition on L Street near 3rd Street and found two of the kidnap victims in the back seat. The officers arrested the driver, 38-year-old Lincoln resident Francisco Roldan, and passenger, 33-year-old Lincoln resident Amy Feliciano. Lincoln officers stopped the GMC Suburban on 5th Street near D Street and found the third kidnap victim inside the vehicle. Lincoln officers arrested the two adult occupants, 29-year-old Lincoln resident Travis Hutson, and 21-year-old Lincoln resident Joshua Logue.

Two of the kidnap victims sustained minor injuries during the incident and were released to their parents. The preliminary investigation by the officers revealed the suspects kidnapped the three juveniles because the suspects believed the juveniles stole Travis Hutson's medical marijuana plants from his back yard the day before. Francisco Roldan, Amy Feliciano, Travis Hutson and Joshua Logue were booked into the Placer County Jail for Kidnapping, Conspiracy, False Imprisonment and Battery.
