Lincoln, CA – On November 22, 2009 at approximately 7:12 PM., the Lincoln Police Department received a call of an adult male that had been stabbed at Joiner Express Mart, located at 151 Joiner Parkway. Officers arrived and found a 21 year old male victim conscious and alert with a single stab wound to his back. The victim was transported via ambulance to a local hospital where he was released hours later with non-life threatening injuries.

The suspect stabbed the victim in the back with an unknown object during a physical confrontation. The suspect is outstanding at this time and officers are investigating some possible leads. UPDATE

On December 3, 2009 at approximately 10:16 AM, Officers from the Lincoln Police Department located the suspect, Johnathan Logue, at his residence on 1st Street. He was detained and transported to Police Headquarters for an interview with detectives. Upon completion of the interview, Logue was transported to the Placer County Jail where he was booked for violation of Penal Code section 245 (a) (1) –Assault with a Deadly Weapon.
