LINCOLN, CA, January 4, 2010 – At approximately 3 p.m. on Sunday, January 3rd, emergency personnel from the Lincoln Police and Fire Departments were dispatched to the area between 1st Street and Ferrari Ranch Road on a report that a train had just struck a pedestrian. On arrival, emergency personnel found the body of an adult male lying next to the train rail on the Auburn Ravine train trestle. The male sustained major trauma and emergency personnel pronounced him dead at the scene.

The incident is being investigated as an accident by the Union Pacific Railroad and the Lincoln Police Department.

The decedent has been identified as 20-year-old Mitchell Austin Jones, a resident of Lincoln.
