### **Lincoln Police Department to Participate in FAST Grant**

LINCOLN, CA, Sept. 2, 2010 – The California Highway Patrol has been awarded the “FAST” grant by the California Office of Traffic Safety to reduce speeding on Placer County Highways. The partnering agencies in this program will include Lincoln Police Department, Roseville Police Department, Rocklin Police Department, and Auburn Police Department. Significant positive impacts are expected on Placer County highways to reduce speeding through enhance speed limit enforcement.

This is a State funded grant and the fiscal impact on the City of Lincoln is none. Lincoln residence should not be surprised to see Lincoln Police Officers working out of the city in the joint regional effort. Partnering agencies will work together in all participating jurisdictions to target Interstate 80, State Route 49 and 65, Sierra College Boulevard, Auburn-Folsom Road, Baseline Road, and other problematic roadways. The grant will continue through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
