### Traffic Accident

Lincoln, CA, Nov. 4, 2008 – At approximately 7:30 a.m. today the Lincoln Police Department and Lincoln Fire Department received a report that a single vehicle had been struck by a train at the Ferrari Ranch Road and Highway 65 railroad crossing.

Upon arrival Fire and Police personnel found a Honda Accord resting in the ditch north of the intersection. Rescue personnel located the sole occupant of the vehicle who was a 27-year-old female resident of Lincoln. Rescue personnel extricated her from the vehicle and she was transported to Sutter Roseville Hospital with apparent minor injuries.

The preliminary investigation indicates that the Honda Accord was traveling east bound on Ferrari Ranch Road crossing the railroad tracks when it was struck by the north bound train. This collision is still under investigation by the Lincoln Police Department.
