ROBBERY ASSAULT IN LINCOLN **SUSPECT IN CUSTODY**

UPDATE

Lincoln, CA. November 15, 2008 — Lincoln Police Officers responded to a possible robbery in progress at the Holiday Inn Express located at 155 Ferrari Ranch Road. Officers determined that a hotel clerk had been assaulted receiving minor injuries, and that property from the establishment had been taken including a 2002 Ford Holiday Inn Express shuttle van. Lincoln Police Detectives identified the suspect in this incident as 23 year old Eric Arredondo

December 3, 2008 at 4:00 PM- As a result of information obtained in this investigation Lincoln Police Detectives responded to a Roseville Ca. residence in the 500 block of Whyte Avenue. On arrival to the area Detectives observed the suspect Eric Arredondo exit the residence. Detectives contacted Arredondo in the front yard area and took him into custody with out incident.

Lincoln Police Detectives also located property at the Whyte Avenue residence connected to the Robbery at the Lincoln Holiday Inn Express. Eric Arredondo was subsequently booked into custody at the Placer County Jail in Auburn and Felony charges of Robbery and Possession of Stolen Property.

This incident is still under investigation by the Lincoln Police Department Investigations Division.
