ROBBERY ASSAULT IN LINCOLN

Lincoln, CA. November 15, 2008 — Lincoln Police Officers responded to a possible robbery in progress at the Holiday Inn Express located at 155 Ferrari Ranch Road. Officers determined that a hotel clerk had been assaulted, receiving minor injuries, and that property from the establishment had been taken including a 2002 Ford Holiday Inn Express shuttle van. The suspect was described as a male having a medium complexion, wavy shoulder length black hair, approximately 6'1" to 6'2" and broad shoulders. He was said to be wearing a hooded bright yellow pull over sweatshirt with draw strings, faded blue jeans, and gray tennis shoes.

Shortly after the suspect fled, the California Highway Patrol recovered the Holiday Inn Express Van at Nicolaus Road and Brewer Road after responding to a vehicle fire.
