SPEED SURVEYS COMPLETED

Lincoln CA. November 4, 2009: On December 10, 2009, new speed limits signs will be posted on various streets throughout the City of Lincoln. Recently, an update to the speed surveys was completed on 26 streets in the City. Every five years speed surveys are conducted to establish a safe speed for vehicular travel, in compliance with section 40802 of the California Vehicle Code.

Out of the 26 surveyed streets, only three streets will receive a new speed posting:

Caledon Circle will be posted at 35 MPH; currently there are no speed limit signs

Aviation Blvd will be posted at 45 MPH; currently the speed limit is 40 MPH

Twelve Bridges Drive between Eastridge Drive and Sierra College Blvd will be posted at 45 MPH; currently the speed limit is 40 MPH

All of the other speed limits will remain the same.

When streets are not posted with speed limits, drivers are to obey the "Prima Facie Speed Limit", which is 25 MPH on residential streets.

Please remember even though there may be speed limits posted, you are required to drive at a speed no greater than is reasonable having due regard for weather, visibility, traffic, the surface and width of the street, and in no event at a speed which endangers the safety of persons or property.

Please drive safely and be aware of the posted speed limits.
