LINCOLN, CA, Feb. 2, 2010 – At approximately 1:30 pm on February 1st, Lincoln Police Officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Edgefield Court regarding a residential burglary in progress. The victim advised that she came home and found two white male juveniles burglarizing her home. The victim grabbed one suspect, and attempted to detain him, but he broke free. The victim was injured during her altercation with the suspect. Both suspects fled the scene. The victim provided descriptions of the suspects and officers searched the area as other officers processed the crime scene.

The crime scene yielded evidence that led to identification of one of the suspects. That suspect was quickly located and arrested on charges of robbery, burglary and conspiracy. The suspect arrested was a 16-year-old white male from Lincoln. Officers continued their investigation in an effort to locate the second suspect.

On February 2nd at about 8:30 a.m., officers located and arrested the second suspect, who was also a 16-year-old white male from Lincoln.

The suspects stole over \$5300 worth of property from the residence. Approximately \$3800 worth of that property was recovered.
