LINCOLN, CA, February 16, 2010 -- At about 8:45 a.m. on Monday, February 15th, Lincoln Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a missing adult. The reporting party stated his wife left their residence on February 14th at about 7 p.m. to go to a pizza parlor and did not return home.

The reporting party stated his wife had sent a text message indicating she was scared and being held against her will by a male subject with a knife. An extensive search and investigation was conducted.

On February 15, 2010 at about 7 p.m. Lincoln police officers located the missing person's car in the parking lot of Joiner Park in Lincoln. The car was not occupied but the engine was warm to the touch.

Officers searched the park on foot and located the missing person, unharmed, behind a large storage container in a grove of trees towards the center of the park. There was a male subject with the missing person.

The male subject was identified as 39-year-old Max Risinger of Lincoln. After additional investigation, Risinger was arrested on suspicion of possessing a concealed weapon and suspicion of kidnapping.
